ENSURE MORE MATERIALS ARE RECYCLED AND KEPT OUT OF LANDFILL BY REMEMBERING THESE PRO-TIPS:

- 1

Line it up. Put your recycling boxes beside each other. Keep 1m (3ft) between your recycling containers and your garbage/green bin.
- 2

Keep it clean. Empty and rinse all containers.
- 3

Flatten and cut. If your cardboard is too large for your blue box, flatten and cut it down to smaller pieces. 30" x 30" (78cm x 78cm) or smaller. Stack them between recycling containers. Remember to keep plastic wrap out of your recycling!
- 4

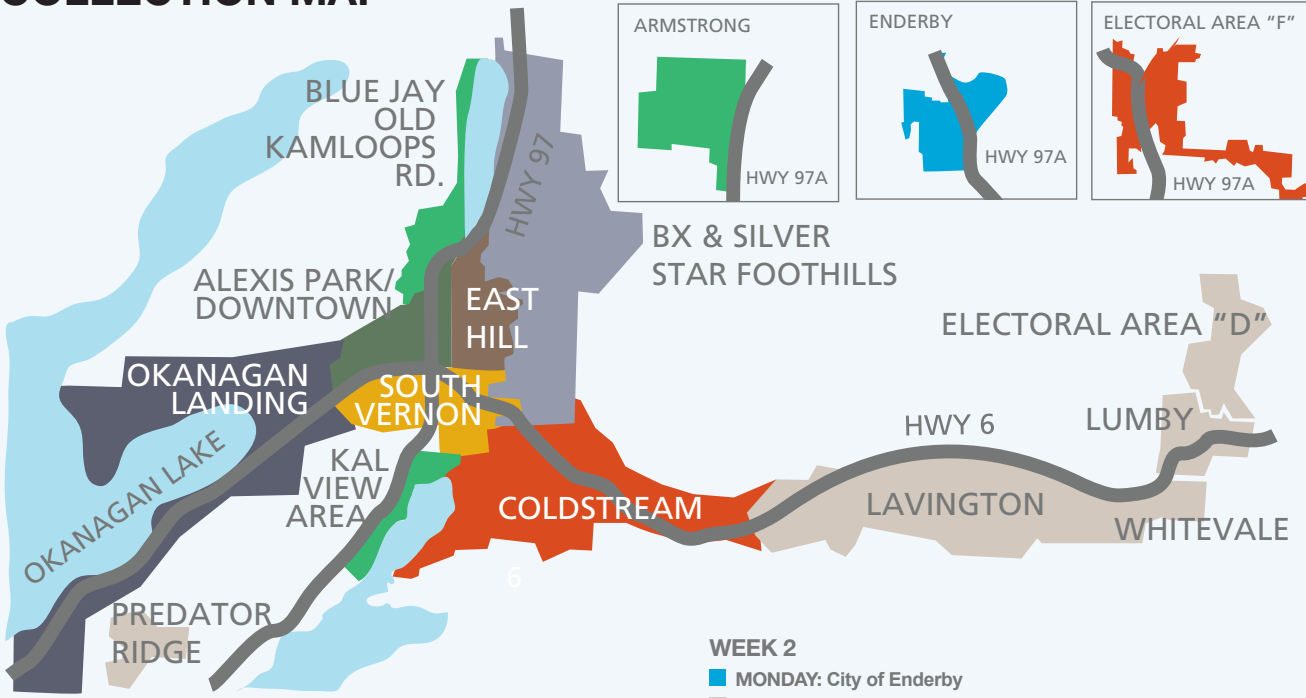

TUESDAY: East Hill Area

North of 25th Ave & East of 27th St. including Shantz and Mutrie Rds, Harwood & Heron areas. (Does NOT include Silver Star Foothills)

WEDNESDAY: Alexis Park/Downtown Area

North of 25th Ave from 27th St. to Allenby, Richfield and Heritage up to 5900; including Downtown, Alexis Park, Turtle Mountain, Bella Vista, Allenby

THURSDAY: South Vernon Area

South of 25th Ave within the City of Vernon including Mission Hill up to Fulton Rd, Polson/VSS areas, Middleton Mtn area up to the Coldstream boundary. (Does NOT include Country Estates).

FRIDAY: Okanagan Landing Area

West of Fulton & Allenby including Tronson Rd, Eastside Rd, Ellison Park, The Rise and Heritage 5900+

MONDAY: City of Enderby

East of Brewer Rd and Warren Rd, Whitevale, Village of Lumby, and North of Lumby up to Trinity Valley Rd

WEDNESDAY: Old Kamloops Rd, Blue Jay Area, Kal View Area & Armstrong

Includes Country Estates, Kalamalka Slopes, Guildford Court, Kal Lakeview, Kickville/Westkal Rd and up Kal Lake Road to #17609, and Armstrong.

THURSDAY: Parts of Coldstream & Electoral Area "F"

Including the Middleton Mtn and Sarsons/Fenwick areas south of Hwy 6, and Coldstream Valley Estates (Does NOT include Kickville/Westkal Rd), and parts of Electoral Area "F"

FRIDAY: BX & Silver Star Foothills

From the Spallumcheen boundary to the Coldstream boundary. (Does NOT include Sarsons/Fenwick area south of Hwy 6).

Plastic garden pots and seedling trays



Caps, tops, lids and pumps



Plastic or paper take-out cups, bowls and lids



Cartons for soup, milk, etc.

Aerosol cans (empty)



Foil wrap and take out containers

- ✓ Plastic packaging for toys, batteries etc. Separate plastic from paper backing
  - ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, chips, etc.
- ✓ Plastic pails less than 25L for laundry detergent, cat litter, etc.
  - ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.

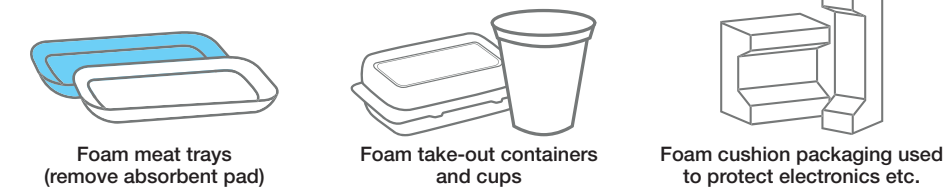
## GLASS



! Put all lids in blue box.

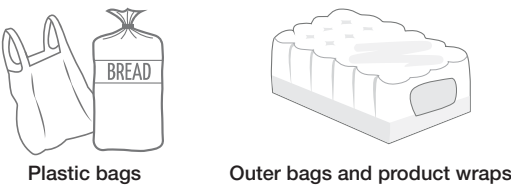
- ✗ Drinking glasses, dishes, cookware
  - ✗ Window glass, mirrors
- ✗ Ceramic products
  - ✗ Light bulbs or light fixtures

## FOAM PACKAGING (return to depot)



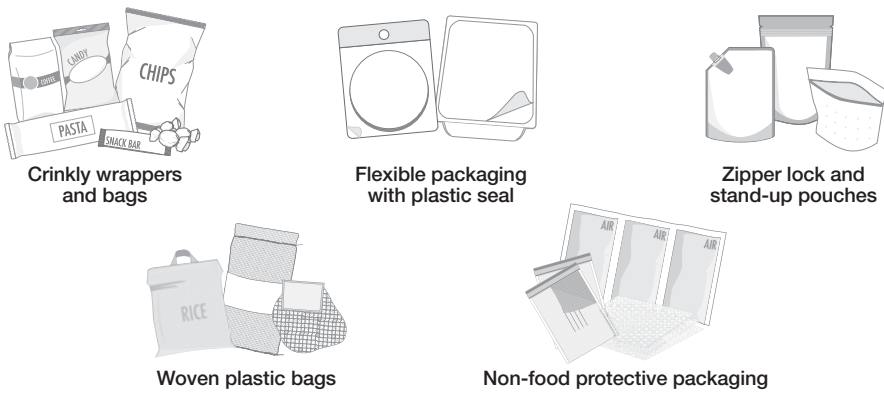
- ✗ Blue or pink foam insulation, packing chips and peanuts
- ✗ Squishy or flexible foam, foam noodles

## PLASTIC BAGS AND OVERWRAP (return to depot)



- ✓ Bags for groceries, produce, dry bulk foods, frozen vegetables, water softener, salt, garden products, newspapers, etc.
- ✓ Overwrap for diapers, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, soft drink flats


## OTHER FLEXIBLE PLASTIC PACKAGING (return to depot)



- ✗ Plastic squeeze tubes, plastic-lined paper, paper-lined plastic, plastic strapping
- ✗ 6-pack rings, biodegradable plastic, vinyl



## NOT ACCEPTED

Do NOT place into Yellow Bag

Plastic bags and overwrap



Clothing and textiles



Food, yard waste and wood

- ✗ Non-paper gift wrap, foil wrap, cards or paper with glitter
- ✗ Rubber bands, ribbons, bows
- ✗ Padded envelopes
- ✗ Bags and boxes with foil liners
- ✗ Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- ✗ Foil or plastic lined paper bags

## NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING, or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.

## NOT ACCEPTED

Hangers, pots, pans and other scrap metal

- ✗ Foam packaging
- ✗ Chip or foil bags, candy wrappers
- ✗ Stand-up pouches
- ✗ Packaging labeled biodegradable or compostable

- ✗ Wiring, metal cords, hardware
- ✗ Clothing, textiles and shoes
- ✗ Food and yard waste
