

ENSURE MORE MATERIALS ARE RECYCLED AND KEPT OUT OF LANDFILL BY REMEMBERING THESE PRO-TIPS:

- 1 Line it up. Put your recycling boxes beside each other. Keep 1m (3ft) between your recycling containers and your garbage/green bin.
- 2 Keep it clean. Empty and rinse all
- 3 Flatten and cut. If your cardboard is too large for your blue box, flatten and cut it down to smaller pieces. 30" x 30" (78cm x 78cm) or smaller. Stack them between recycling containers. Remember to keep plastic wrap out of your recycling!



NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.


