

- 3 Flatten and cut. If your cardboard is too large for your blue box, flatten and cut it down to smaller pieces. 30" x 30" (76cm x 76cm) or smaller. Stack them between recycling containers. Remember to keep plastic wrap out of your recycling!





Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING, or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.




