

RECYCLING TIPS

You can help ensure that more materials are recycled by following these steps:

- 1. Empty and rinse containers. Containers with contents remaining cannot be recycled and can harm workers or damage machinery. Rinsing also helps reduce odours and pests.
- 2. Add materials loose to the recycling container. Only shredded paper should be inside a paper bag or box before being added to your recycling.
- Save space by flattening boxes and cartons. Stack containers that held the same contents, such as yogurt pots.

(for curbside collection services) and depots where you can drop off materials that are not collected at the curb. The MMBC program is funded by the businesses that supply packaging and paper to BC residents, shifting recycling costs away

LINE UP YOUR RECYCLING

Place your yellow bag between your grey box and your blue box, not across the top of them. Allow 1 m (3 ft) between your recycling containers and your green bin and garbage bin.



PAPER

PUT INTO REUSABLE RECYCLING BAGS **RECYCLE AT CURBSIDE OR DEPOT**







Packaging and printed paper accepted for recycling

✓ Newspapers, inserts, flyers, catalogues, magazines, telephone books

Place loose in container. Remove from plastic wrap.

- ✓ Household paper, paper gift wrap, greeting cards
- Boxboard boxes

ACCEPTED

Remove liners and food. Flatten and place in recycling container.

- Moulded boxboard for egg cartons, beverage carry-out trays, etc.
- ✓ Paper bags with single and multiple paper or plastic layers for pet food, flour, etc.

- Cores from paper towel and toilet tissue
- Corrugated cardboard

Remove plastic wrap from cardboard flats. Staples and tape OK. If too large for recycling container, flatten and cut to no larger than 30" wide (78cm) x 30" tall (78cm). Stack neatly and securely place beside or between recycling containers.

Shredded paper

Place shredded paper inside a paper bag or box to prevent it from mixing with container recycling or blowing away.

Please do NOT include these with curbside recycling

★ Plastic bags used to cover newspapers/flyers Bring to a depot

- * Rubber bands

- ✓ Plastic or paper take-out cups, bowls,

- Cartons for soup, milk, sauces, ice cream, etc.
- ✓ Metal cans and lids for food
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans and caps
- ✓ Microwavable bowls and cups
- ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, chips, etc.
- ✓ Aluminum foil wrap, aluminum foil take-out containers
- ✔ Plastic bottles, jugs, jars, tubs, and trays
- Caps, tops, lids, and pumps

- ✓ Plastic packaging for toys, batteries, electronics, tooth brushes, etc. Separate plastic from paper backing.
- Rigid plastic clamshells for baked goods, fruit, eggs, etc.
- ✓ Plastic garden plant pots and seedling trays
- ✔ Plastic pails, less than 25L, for laundry detergent, pet food, etc.

REMEMBER:

- ✓ Empty and rinse containers; labels OK.
- ✓ Put metal lids inside cans and squeeze
- ✓ Return deposit containers for refund.


