## RECYCLING TIPS

You can help ensure that more materials are recycled by following these steps:

- 1 Place your blue boxes side by side. Allow 1m (3 ft) between your blue boxes and your garbage bin and green bin.
- 2 Empty and rinse containers.
- 3 Contain shredded paper inside a paper bag or box before adding to your recycling.
- 4 Flatten cardboard, remove plastic wrap from cardboard flats. If too large for recycling container, flatten and cut to no larger than 30" wide (78 cm) by 30" tall (78 cm). Stack neatly and securely place beside or between recycling containers.

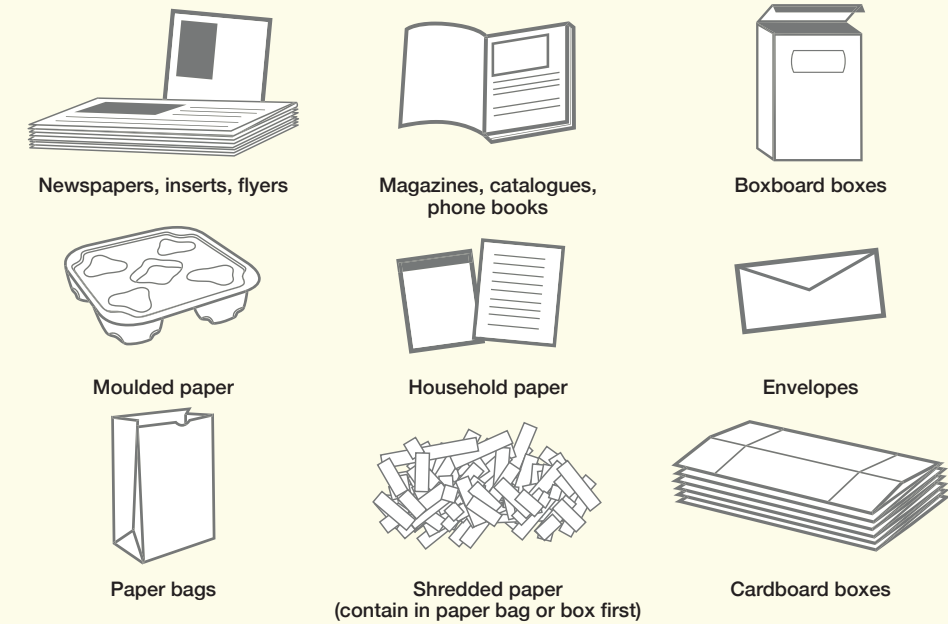
## Unused Medication

- ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, chips, etc.
- ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.

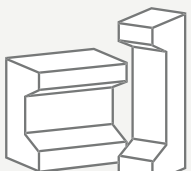
## FOAM PACKAGING

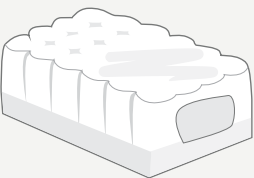

## PLASTIC BAGS AND OVERWRAP

Outer bags and product wraps

- ✓ Bags for groceries, produce, dry bulk foods, frozen vegetables, water softener, salt, garden products, newspapers, etc.
- ✓ Overwrap for diapers, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, soft drink flats

Return deposit containers for a refund.



## NOT ACCEPTED

Do NOT place into Blue Box



- ✗ Non-paper gift wrap, foil wrap, cards or paper with glitter
- ✗ Rubber bands, ribbons, bows
- ✗ Padded envelopes
- ✗ Bags and boxes with foil liners
- ✗ Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- ✗ Foil or plastic lined paper bags

## NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.

## NOT ACCEPTED

Do NOT place into Blue Box



- ✗ Foam packaging
- ✗ Chip or foil bags, candy wrappers
- ✗ Stand up pouches
- ✗ Packaging labeled biodegradable or compostable
- ✗ Wiring, metal cords, hardware
- ✗ Clothing, textiles and shoes
- ✗ Food and yard waste

- ✗ Drinking glasses, dishes, cookware
- ✗ Window glass, mirrors
- ✗ Ceramic products
- ✗ Light bulbs or light fixtures
- ✗ Blue or pink foam insulation, packing chips and peanuts
- ✗ Squishy or flexible foam, foam noodles
- ✗ Crinkly wrap for tea, floral arrangements etc.
- ✗ Pasta and cereal bags, chip and snack bags, stand-up pouches
- ✗ Zipper lock bags, garbage bags, kitchen stretch wrap
- ✗ Plastic shipping envelopes, bubble packaging
