

Line it up. Put your yellow bag between your boxes,

Keep it clean. Empty and rinse containers to prevent ntamination, recycle more materials, and avoid

not on top. Leave about 1m (3 feet) of space between recycling boxes/bags and your garbage/organic bins.

Avoid litter. Don't overfill your recycling boxes. If you an't fit everything comfortably, contact Recycle BC's collection partner for an additional box or use a similar open box (like a laundry basket or storage box) to sort your material properly.

ENSURE MORE MATERIALS ARE RECYCLED AND KEPT

OUT OF LANDFILL BY REMEMBERING THESE PRO-TIPS:

OOPS! Did you receive an Oops tag on collection day?

Our collection partners may leave these behind if your material is unable to be collected. The tag will indicate the issue.



- Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.




