





## **PAPER**

### **PUT INTO YELLOW BAG**

Cut excess cardboard to 76 cm x 76 cm (30 in x 30 in) and stack beside bag Clean and dry paper only



## **CONTAINERS**

#### **PUT INTO BLUE BOX**

Put all hard plastic, metal, and carton containers, and paper cups, into the Containers box. Empty and rinse containers.

# As of January 1, 2025, the following sorting changes apply:

Flexible plastics (wrappers, plastic bags, etc.) go in the red/pink box.



Please use provided "flexible plastics" decal on your existing pink/red box: pee off the sticker and lay the decal over the longer side of your pink/red box. Ensure the surface area is clean and dry before application. Remember to use your existing pink/red boxes for flexible plastics only.

Plastic and metal containers, cartons, and paper cups go in the blue box.



### **Unused Medication**

Empty medication containers can be recycled with Recycle BC, but unused or expired medications can be safely disposed by returning them to community pharmacies. For more information or to find the nearest pharmacy, please visit

### **NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS**

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; containers with the words COMBUSTIBLE, FLAMMABLE or VERY FLAMMABLE on them (except cosmetic and beauty product containers); compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or bear spray; or containers for pesticides labelled POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.



There are no sorting changes to the materials accepted in the yellow bag and grey box.
